



Qualitative Health Research: Advanced Module

Description

The advanced module provides an opportunity to refine skills in qualitative health research. In interactive sessions, participants will review their own progress in terms of the scope of qualitative health research, various research designs and qualitative data collection techniques. The emphasis of the course will be on qualitative data analysis and on the writing and evaluation of qualitative research papers.

Objectives

By the end of the course, participants will have improved their skills in qualitative health research and feel confident to carry out their own projects from data collection to data analysis and the publishing of their papers. This course builds on the introductory module in qualitative health research.
