Before, he has worked for several clinics in Germany in the area of medical development. He has been a pioneer in the analysis of the newly introduced DRG system in Germany and in the advancement of the German Inpatient Quality Indicators (G-IQI) and its Swiss counterpart, the Swiss Inpatient Quality Indicators (CH-IQI).</p> <p>He received his education as a medical specialist in internal medicine at the University of Luebeck and completed his habilitation in the field of medical informatics.</p>
