

Conducting Qualitative Research in Health: An Introduction to Qualitative Data Analysis

Description	<p>When to start qualitative analysis? How to prepare the data in order to make qualitative data analysis easy? How to analyse effectively large amounts of interview material? How to use computer-based data analysis programme?</p> <p>These and other questions will be addressed by this course. It provides support to students who are planning to or at the beginning of analyzing qualitative empirical data.</p>
Objectives	<p>Participants will learn how to interpret empirical data in the light of theoretical knowledge in order to answer their research questions. By the end of the course, participants will be able to develop an analysis plan, to decide on the best theoretical method to analyze their empirical data and will know about the process of data analysis and its quality standards.</p>
